NOTES FROM LAST NEW MINISTRY STEERING COMMITTEE...

The members of the New Church Steering Committee, along with the Rev. Steven Wilco, met for their fourth meeting since May 13 on Tuesday evening, June 25, at St. Andrew Church.

They continued to do the "foundation" work of building a new congregation. Among the steps taken at the meeting:


- Prepared for joint worship service at Stafford Ave. on June 30, and the "Naming" event to immediately follow worship.
- Elected officers for the new congregation from the membership of the Steering Committee. Elected were: Bob Herold, President; Bob Cummiskey, Vice-President; Linda Klopp, Secretary; and Sandy Milke, Treasurer.
- Completed work on the Constitution for the new congregation following Model Constitution for congregations of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. The Constitution will be voted for approval on September 29, when all three congregations will be voting to incorporate the new ministry.
- Reviewed drafts of job descriptions for interim positions of Minister of Music, Office Administrator, and custodial services.
- Received draft copies of the Ministry Site Profile describing the new congregation, outlining its goals
 for ministry, and basic qualities/skills we are seeking in a new pastor. This document will be provided
 to potential pastoral candidates as introduction to congregation and as starting point for
 conversation with them. Heard that Britt Lynch is serving as chair of the Call Committee and that
 they will soon be ready to receive a candidate (or candidates).
- Heard brief reports from some of the nine ministry committees that have been formed or that are in
 the process of being formed (Property, Worship and Music, Outreach and Meals for Neighbors, Faith
 Formation for Adults and Children/Youth, Reconciling In Christ process, Finance, Parish Life;
 Evangelism, Stewardship. Brief descriptions of the work of these ministry teams will be offered at the
 June 30 "Naming" event and people will be invited to offer their help with the development of the
 many ministries.

The next meeting of the Steering Committee will be held at Grace Church in Plainville, Tuesday, July 23, 6:30 p.m.

Karen Biernat, Bill Golden and Bob Herold are the elected representatives from St. Andrew serving on the Committee. They are always eager to talk with you about the work of the Committee and invite you to share in it! And keep the whole Committee in your prayers as they tend faithfully to their huge responsibilities!
